At Play for All we aim to provide a secure, stimulating and fun environment that is welcoming and will encourage all children aged 4-11 years to develop to their full potential. We are committed to providing the highest standard of care in a fun atmosphere whilst actively promoting equal opportunities and continuing to provide effective learning experiences for all children. Play for All is where children can discover, achieve and express themselves through active play and where parents feel confident to leave their child in safety.

At Play for All we are fortunate to have a highly experienced, capable and committed team of staff. Our Unit Manager and Designated Child Protection Officer Kirsty Kennedy has over 15 years' experience in childcare and holds a Level 5 in Leadership and Management in Childcare, Learning and Development. Kirsty is assisted by Emma Hudson (Deputy Leader) and assistant Kiera Phillips. All of our staff are trained in paediatric first aid and child protection.

Our afterschool club is based in the P1 classroom at Ballycarrickmaddy and operates from 2pm-6pm (12pm for early school closures) Monday - Friday during term time and from 8am-6pm during school holidays. The setting is well equipped with resources and activities for the children who play a big part in our planning to ensure their needs and interests are always our primary concern.

Payments need to be made a month in advance- always before the 28th. Payments via cash, cheque, BACS (details on your invoice), and childcare vouchers are all accepted. All days must be paid for during term-time regardless if your child is off sick or you have holidays booked during term time. Two months' notice is needed if you decide to take your child out of Play for All. A retainer fee of 50% will hold your place for non-usage during July & August, alternatively you can choose days to the equivalent. **Late Fee:** We hold a strict late fee policy of £20 per 15minutes for those collecting outside of opening hours.
