- Sleeper Edge to retain gravel
- 3tn of Gravel for area around pirate ship and benches
- 2 ton of gravel for around new outdoor classroom
- Sleepers to make raised beds to house bark/stones for outdoor play



- Development of the forest area: long logs, 32 log seats
 - Wooden Bridge to add interest in the Forest (still to be installed)
 - Rope for construction
 - Tarpaulins for forest area and cord to make shelters
 - Flint and Steel for forest campfires
 - Trivet for campfire
 - Swing for forest area
 - Consumable Messy Play items: compost, shaving foam, slime, jelly, food colouring...
 - Plantex for under the bark and stones
 - Bark and stones for play area within new raised beds
 - Grass mats x 20 for Key Stage 1 grass area
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- Teachers' Grants £100 x 8 issued in June 2023
 - Subsidised P7 school trip £750
